Johnathan's below conclusions are all half-baked and are deceptions. He advances the following sophistry:

“My Question is; How can Jesus be the Lord's Christ? as the verse below shows in Luke 2:26 when here Derek clearly shows Christ as being the father of Jesus in the verse above Isa 53. Thus Derek eliminates God the Father making Christ the Father and Jesus the Christ, which he declares that Christ is separate from Jesus. Derek does not eliminate Father. Christ during His ministry proclaimed that no one knows Him but the Son. He also said the person Whom the Jewish church called their God; was a stranger to them. He said, *“It is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God: Yet ye have not known him...”* Therefore, to presume that the person called, Lord, in *Isa 53* is Father, a text in which Jewish scholars would have been quite familiar with, is to contradict the above cited statements from the *Testimony of Jesus*, and, as a consequence, risk falling in the Slaughter described in *Rev 12*. *Isa 53* mentions nothing about Father. The MSC E-mail in which Johnathan refers to entitled, *His Arm Does*, clearly proves that Christ was defined as the Lord; that was His name. The name of Father, the Being Whom Christ recognizes as His God, was first introduced to the church during the *Testimony of Jesus* as prior E-mail, *Father's Day & the Tongue of Heaven*, clearly proves. Christ was the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; He was the light of the OT Church; He is the light of the world. His name is Lord, and He is called, “the Lord”. Thus Johnathan's inferential conclusion that *Isa 53* refers to Father leading Jesus to slaughter is a historic assumption because we presumed that Jesus was Christ; it is not bible-validated theology. Thus I pose the same question which Isaiah does: Who hath believed our report? You must first find the one, the man *“...to whom the Arm of the Lord is revealed...”* It is not a historically accredited, traditionally accepted, popular report. We know that Johnathan does not believe the report, will you?
