Shine out of my Heart

Brother Arthur Gibbs,

You wrote to me seeking to contradict the *Shepherd's Rod Message* with statements from EGW —what a monumental exercise in futility! Please do not waste your time or my time in any such future doctrinal enterprise. Just as you/we learned to sing through the entirety oall of our Adventist experience, *Let Jesus come into your heart*, just so is this my appeal to you on this Sabbath morning.

Maybe I have not been clear: I am not here to defend the *Shepherd's Rod Message* taught by its founder VT Houteff (VTH); although, I believe in its and his divine inspiration. I am commissioned to trumpet the clarion call affirmed by both VTH and EGW. That clarion message is that, in the day of strong meat, all doctrines must be forged by the Bible and that we must leave behind, aka circumcise our hearts, from the doctrines graced to us yesterday by the *Spirit of Prophecy*.
