Reply to Donna,

As was the Lord when He pondered upon the path and plight of the disciple who was to betray Him, I too am troubled in spirit over your words. You make the following misrepresentation about the MSC urging the forum to receive not this vessel, the man whom the Lord hath sent to the disciples, Davidia:

“Honestly brethren, why do you all keep going back and forth with Derek, ...He keeps asking people on the group to prove what he teaches in error and when they do, does he ever accept it, no. Especially when anyone shows from either Sis. White and/or Bro. Houteff writings he will say to show from the Bible and the Bible only, but he and/or Vinnette (Derek’s helpmeet) don’t have a problem using their writings to say something to others on the forum. So, my question to the group is why are we still battling this when nothing is going to change. We have all been going back and forth with Derek as well as he with us, when are we just going to wipe the dust off of our feet and move on...” —Your E-mail, Saturday, February 23, 2008 10:3PM

The reason for the back and forth communications is clear to all who have spiritual perceptions: the Lord has troubled the water. This trouble will continue until the sad day when the rebels in the Lord’s church, especially in Davidia are found on the outside of the Kingdom looking in and weeping and gnashing their teeth.

Regarding refutation of the MSC, all on the forum well know that the doctrines of the MSC have never been defeated. None have ever even contradicted the MSC legally from the works of VTH or EGW either. Like Judas, you have poised and presumed a pernicious posture on this question. Some like Walt, suggest that vegetarianism is the key contradiction. He and others elevate the church’s spin on vegetarianism, their additions and false estimation to EGW’s counsel on that subject as sound evidence to refute the MSC doctrine. However, by the examining deeper themes of EGW’s work, it becomes certain that such a conclusion is false for this hour of church history. Instead of expressing that a vegetarian diet manifest “good works”, she defines for all how to learn to choose the good and refuse the evil and resultantly practice

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righteousness. Her most dominant theme is that all doctrines, all teachings of good and bad, require a Bible foundation. She said the following as an example:

“Every member of the body should feel that the salvation of his own soul depends upon his own individual effort. Souls cannot be saved without exertion...Instead of looking to Brother & Sister White to help them out of darkness, they should be earnestly engaged in helping themselves...If the people lean upon Bro & Sr. White, and trust in them, God will humble them among you or remove them from you. You must look to God and trust in Him. Lean upon Him and He will not forsake you. He will not leave you to perish. PRECIOUS IS THE WORD OF GOD. ‘Search the Scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life.’ These are the words of Christ. The words of inspiration, carefully and prayerfully studied and practically obeyed, will thoroughly furnish you unto all good works...”—EGW, Vol 2, p. 121

The MSC can readily produce over 80 similar statements whereby EGW clearly insists that we must secure our light from the Bible as a formula for **“all good works”**. Walt desires to ignore those themes and still pretend to follow the writings of EGW. He, and others suggest that vegetarianism is a good, life-preserving work; but he refuses to heed EGW and Christ’s sound command to establish “goodness” from the Bible. In fact, all in the abomination loving SDA church, in their path towards *Ezek nine*, ever seeking to worship God in perversity—including Davidia— have refused to heed EGW’s counsel to turn to the Bible for doctrine, all doctrine! Consequently, just as EGW has promised, the Lord has removed her and VTH from amongst us because we have not used our own powers of **“exertion”**. This theme of Bible primacy as opposed to SOP primacy, or the teaching that our faith must become predicated upon the Bible, was her most dominant theme. The fact that you missed this dimension of her work is because you have not heeded to the ministry of the Mustard Seed, “light of Israel”, the son of David (see Isa 49, 2 Sam 23: 1-4, 2 Chr 21: 5-7, Isa 55: 1-4). Perhaps Donna, you and the forum have confused EGW & VTH with Joseph Smith of Mormonism. In the early 1800s, he claims to have received divine revelations and to have produced an inspired work that was extra-biblical: he taught that he had received an addition to the Bible for the *latter day saints*. Instead of doing like MSA and EGW beforehand, he did not point the people back to the words of Christ but to his newly uncovered transcripts. EGW, a righteous prophet, did not model her inspiration after his; therefore, Davidia should stop conducting their ministry like Mormons. The very fact that the MSC is required to teach Davidians such concepts of distinctions, the very fact that Davidian headquarters like Bashan, Carmel, Salem, Mountindale, etc do not comprehend this point, the very fact that your teacher from Salem cannot explain to you why life-saving doctrines cannot be founded solely upon EGW’s writings, conclusively show how far from Christ His people have drifted. You have the *Rod*, but you have abandoned the Shepherd, you have cast aside your “Bread of Life”! Like Judas, you have caused the Lord to be troubled in spirit by your cozied and illicit plottings with His enemies. And beyond that, you presume, also like Judas, that your corrupt hands can forward the cause of God by idle, E-mail chatter over the tarnished jewels which human hands have uncovered from their cursory examination of inspiration. You do not realize that only a traitor, a man such as Judas would seek to take the Word of God and smother it with the work of EGW; only his character would seek to dip his **Bread in SOP**. Notice the sop dipped bread came from the very hands of Jesus: just like the works of EGW and VTH, it was an inspired revelation to the disciples. Unfortunately, its symbolism manifest that, at the end of the day as Jesus completed His communion with Laodicean, His last church, those who do not have their spiritual teeth to consume their Bread on its own merits—without softening it with SOP— are, like Judas, men and women who betray their Lord. Consider another point regarding the above reference from EGW, her statement completely agrees with the Bible; in fact, it quotes the *Testimony of Jesus* in John 5:39 therefore does the MSC unabashedly cite it, even though the MSC recognizes Bible primacy. Such a tactic, that which you insist on condemning, the use of quotes from the SOP by a publication that esteems

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the Bible as the supreme authority is not hard to comprehend or understand. If the MSC established doctrine by solely citing the SOP, then the charge of hypocrisy may be legitimate; however, The MSC never does such a thing. To the contrary, it only uses their work, as was intended, to reinforce Bible doctrines. Consider both the above and below quote as an example. Above, EGW is quoting the Lord in John 5: 39 and she is urging upon the church that we begin to embrace His words to produce “good works”. She affirms that He commands even our thought processes our theories, our thinking, pertaining to salvation. She echoes the Lord by demanding that all forge their theories of salvation from their search of Scripture. Contrary to this clear mandate from Christ and EGW, Walt and others teach vegetarianism as theory for man to win eternal life for the saints today. Some have even conjured up unproven quotes from EGW which suggest that non vegetarians will not be “translated”. Such a teaching is a vile sin, an abomination, for to make that assertion without Bible basis is a clear and flagrant violation—not just of EGW’s counsel, but— of the *Testimony of Jesus*, the very testimony which the Bible in *Rev 12* and *VTH* by quoting such a text in his work, promises to preserve us from the Slaughter. This is especially true since the Lord Himself promised to serve flesh in the Kingdom. Therefore, it is you, Walt, and all on the forum who support such a theory of “eternal life” that have abandoned the SOP and the Bible. This is the reason why the Lord has refused to cease the MSC efforts to save you. Allow me to supply you with another Bible-validated statement from EGW:

“A great work can be done by presenting to the people the Bible just as it reads. Carry the word of God to every man's door, urge its plain statements upon every man's conscience, repeat to all the Saviour's command: "Search the Scriptures." Admonish them to take the Bible as it is, to implore divine enlightenment, and then, when the light shines, to gladly accept each precious ray and fearlessly abide the consequences.”

“The downtrodden law of God is to be exalted before the people; as soon as they turn with earnestness and reverence to the Holy Scriptures, light from heaven will reveal to them wondrous things out of God's law. Great truths that have long been obscured by superstition and false doctrine will blaze forth from the illuminated pages of the Sacred Word. The living oracles pour forth their treasures new and old, bringing light and joy to all who will receive them. Many are roused from their slumber. They rise as it were from the dead and receive the light and life which Christ alone can give. Truths which have proved an overmatch for giant intellects are understood by babes in Christ. To these is plainly revealed that which has clouded the spiritual perception of the most learned expositors of the word, because, like the Sadducees of old, they were ignorant of the Scriptures and of the power of God.”—EGW, *Testimony for the Church*, Vol 5., 388

Examine the next statement from EGW:

“A union of believers with Christ will as a natural result lead to a union with one another, which bond of union is the most enduring upon earth. We are one in Christ, as Christ is one with the Father. Christians are branches, and only branches, in the living Vine. One branch is not to borrow its sustenance from another. Our life must come from the parent vine. It is only by personal union with Christ, by communion with Him daily, hourly, that we can bear the fruits of the Holy Spirit.” —EGW, *Testimony for the Church* Vol 5, p 47, 48

This above quote further explains your frustration with the forum and the MSC: you clearly desire unity and such a quality is grossly lacking in Davidia. EGW gives the reason. Because her reason is confirmed by the Bible, specifically, the Lord’s testimony in *John 15*, then the MSC feels justified in using it. Our unity will come only when we cease to secure our “sap” from other disciples such as VTH and EGW, Don Adair, Jemmy Bingham, etc, and begin to secure it from the Vine, Christ. You can never have such unity when you seek to attach your branch to other branches, other disciples, and not to the Vine, Christ. Such is your failure when you teach vegetarianism as a requisite of eternal salvation and do so directly in contradiction to the words of Christ who promised to serve the saints flesh therein, to cite merely one example. The miracle of the MSC is that it trumpets the theme of Bible primacy; while, at the same time, it validates VTH and EGW, it validates the temporary deployment of vegetarianism as a self imposed affliction of the soul during the *Day of Atonement* (antitypally) as required by Lev 23:29

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I hope that this E-mail will be a final re-iteration explaining the MSC use of the Bible and the SOP.

One final note: you insist upon discussing the confederacy. You are not prepared for the Lord's revelation of that doctrine simply because you have proven to be spiritually incapacitated by all of His other doctrines which have violated your plans and expectations. To understand the confederacy, you must first understand the identity of the Israel, Judah, the house of David, Syria, and the Assyrian. When you learn to appreciate the Lord's light as revealed to date by the MSC, then the Lord will advance you forward to receive even more startling explanations of prophecy.
