This, your below E-mail, appears to be another reference that I can add to my quiver which manifests, in the clearest of terms, that all messages are to be measured by the Bible. Over and over again she says test all doctrines by the Bible. Therefore, I think that my point has been made, and I will not add your reference to my other 84 especially since it is probably a compilation and some —not necessarily the MSA— lend less credence to that use of her work.

It is curious that you highlighted EGW’s warning without any emphasis upon her qualifier: Test all doctrines by the Bible. Since she makes that claim and you ignore it, her most dominant theme, then why should we accept your highlighted message? Have you achieved a master’s degree in ignorance of the SOP’s whereby you can teach the church what themes to highlight and which ones to ignore?
