You deceptively, consistently, and continuously ignore the facts regarding the Testimony of Jesus and, instead, seek to circumvent His life saving Word. To believe on Him, He never said that we must get His name correctly; instead, the Lord said, “*had you believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words*” —John 5: 46, 47. You make the following statement suggesting that Jesus acted alone and without help, a theme which counters the message of Moses pertaining to Jesus:

“Again the Christ does not mention Jesus as a witness, why? because Jesus is the Christ and because; “If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true” Say’s the Speaker Christ.” —your E-mail, March 27, 2010, 10:11 PM

Moses did not say of Christ what you claim that he said: He did not say, The Lord will raise Himself, put His words in His own mouth, and prophesy in His own name. He did not say that He, the Lord, will be His own prophet, patterning Himself after Moses, His servant, to teach the world righteousness. After all, Moses was Christ’s servant, why should He emulate him? Yet is this not what you suggest by claiming that Jesus did not have the hidden presence of Christ upon Him telling Him what to say? Does your logic not claim that Christ raised Himself up after the example of Moses to teach the church? Instead, the statement that Moses made which we must believe to believe on Christ was as follows:

“The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me unto him ye shall hearken. According to all that thou desiredst of the Lord thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the Lord my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not. And the Lord said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken. I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth: and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him” —Deut 18: 15-19.

Notice what Moses promises: the Lord will speak through the Prophet. He says, “*whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.*” Moses promises that the Testimony would be spoken by the prophet; therefore, it is the “Prophet,” Jesus’ testimony. It was His face, His tongue, His lips which articulated Christ’s words. He was given this very assignment by the Father so as to perfectly conceal the fact that Christ was upon Him. This is the very reason why Christ raises the Prophet: so that He does not violate His covenant and speak the words Himself. Christ Inspired Jesus to speak in His, Christ’s, name. This is what Moses promised of Christ! It is what He wrote of Christ. According to the Lord Himself, all true Christians can only believe on Christ by embracing the things that Moses wrote of Him. He said, “*...If ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words.*” Notice the truism of this as it applies to you and Jeanie’s cult: (1) You do not believe the Lord when He said that the Comforter is a Male. (2) You do not believe His word about the divine family claiming that male and female disciples would comprise it; they will be His brothers and sisters and mother. (3) You do not believe that the embrace of the *Testimony of Jesus* will give you life. (4) You do not believe that “Father” is the name that we should use to address God; instead, you seek to find His Hallowed name which you seek to tarnish. And you embrace many other falsehoods. It is evident and clear: You and Jeannie are not real Christians; you are pretenders, wolves concealed in sheepcotes. You reject Moses’ prophecies of Christ.

Why not just admit it; why continue to live the lie and pretend? The thrust of our three-year communications, things that were written and expressed by *Feminist-Branch* believers, revealed that a supernatural voice in your head and in the heads of the other *Feminist-Branch* believers has
