Beware of Tradition's Dark Seal, II

Arthur,

This is a fourth reply. You, in response to my last letter, gave me quotes from what appears to be EGW. Perhaps you did not read my reply to you. Your latest was sent at 10: 15 PM; mine was sent at 9: 44PM, nearly a ½ hour beforehand. You may choose to read or not read my work, I do not care, but it will be broadcasted to help others.

Assuming that you did read it, then let me get this straight. You accuse me of not following the Scripture, and then you issue quotes from non-scriptural sources to prove your thesis. EGW said throughout her ministry to base all findings of doctrine on the Bible —not upon her renditions of the Bible. The question that you must answer in the light of our conversation today is as follows: Is Jesus the same as the Dove who descended upon Him and spoke through Him? If, as the MSC proves, that Dove was Christ, the Creator of the world; The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; the Spirit that was/is Holy, then, though you may have proof that Jesus did indeed die and was resurrected, an understanding that I do not dispute, your work as a minister is not finished. You also must prove that the Dove, Christ who abode upon Him also died to be resurrected. In other words, you must account for an additional Personality. After all, the Dove was the Power, based upon the Law and the prophecies, who spoke through Jesus, a power that, according to Moses, was Christ; therefore, He could not be the Prophet upon whom and through whom He promised to clandestinely speak. Remember, *“To the Law and to the Testimonies: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light (sunrise) in them —Isa 8:20”*.

Because we confused the names of Jesus and Christ yesterday, our day of spiritual night, does not mean that we cannot follow the prophetic path which has been mapped out for the church so as to cast aside the milk, leave the principle doctrines of Christ, and move onward to perfection. There were many lights in the night; EGW was a great one; however, this is the day of sunrise, the day when we must deny to ourselves the dark seal of tradition and receive the seal of this work, the angel who ascends from the east.
