The Seal of Father, Part I

Dear Brother,

Thank you for your reply and for giving me an opportunity to teach more of the righteousness of Christ. Apparently, you have not heard a matter before seeking to answer it — a gross dereliction of ministerial duty. You stated the following:

“Scripture is good, and it clearly teaches that: God the eternal Son became incarnate in Jesus Christ. Through Him all things were created, the character of God is revealed, the salvation of humanity is accomplished, and the world is judged. Forever truly God, He became also truly man, Jesus the Christ. He was conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived and experienced temptation as a human being, but perfectly exemplified the righteousness and love of God. By His miracles He manifested God’s power and was attested as God’s promised Messiah. He suffered and died voluntarily on the cross for our sins and in our place, was raised from the dead, and ascended to minister in the heavenly sanctuary in our behalf. He will come again in glory for the final deliverance of His people and the restoration of all things. Your analysis parrots the historic findings of Roman Catholicism as installed under Emperor Constantine. Accordingly, it is greatly flawed. Instead of serving up theological double speak that unauthorized Christians have conjured over the past 2000 years, read the newsletter and uncover the fact that, by Bible declaration, only the son of David, aka, the Star of David, was promised to purvey the name of the Lord (His identity). *“Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the Lord...when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee...He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom **FOR EVER**”* —2Sam 7: 8, 12, 13. Christ re-affirms as much in His admonition: After feeding the 5,000, He crossed the Sea of Tiberius (Sea of Galilee that was renamed after the Roman governor) and brought the Church by His proverbial counsel to the other side of the theological Catholic experience —the very place where we stand today as a church. On that side of our Christian sojourn, He told us how to receive the seal of Father. He did so by reprimanding the church for seeking after His bread, His milk purveyance of the Gospel, and commanded us to do the following:

“...Ye seek me not because ye saw the miracles but because ye did eat of the loaves and were filled (rich and increased with yesterday’s goods). Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man (not Him, Christ, but His promised Star, the son of David) shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed... And this is the Father’s will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son (not Him, Christ, but His promised Star, the son of David), and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him (not Christ, but His promised Star, the son of David) up at the last day.” —John 6: 26, 27, 39, 40

This strong-meat, Bible purveyance precludes us, those who are to be sealed without receiving death, from understanding Christ (His identity) by revelations from New-Testament commentators (saints who have been tossed to and fro on that tumultuous Roman Catholic passage/sea), revelations from men who do not accordingly seek miracles today. Teachers such as the Pope, teachers such as Mark-of-the-Beastian parrots and enthusiasts, even teachers from fundamental Adventist beliefs are all excluded as last-day teachers of Christ; they do not distribute the meat which can seal them and win for them life without death, aka, everlasting life.
