You have had the benefit of nearly five years of my work on the forum and, ostensibly, to no avail. You should know, had you been dutiful in your requisite to investigate, then you would have settled upon the legitimacy of my calling at the very beginning of my forum work and would have, by now, long since been counted among the disciples. I hope that you appreciate my posture: The MSC is a firm proponent of the Fourth Commandment, especially the second clause which mandates that in the first six days of the week the saints are to do all their work. Over the past five years, many weeks have come and gone. You may not realize that, part of our work is to investigate, to **“Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a WORKMAN that needeth not to be ashamed...”** —2Tim 2: 15. It is wrong for the MSC to rewrite its work to supplement the duty of other saints who have been lax in their responsibility to investigate.

As a dutiful teacher, I still must give to you an overview so as to steer you to some resolution to your query. Thus, I must say that the MSC does not measure the Bible by the SOP; it does the opposite. Your concern pertaining to *Ezek nine* and to Elijah, in case you have forgotten, were learned by all Davidians through VTH's Bible scholarship. He did not, on his own spiritual power, conjure them up like the Witch of Endor. I embraced those doctrines 32 years ago because of my respect for the Lord and His word. Furthermore, your suggestion is that if I would answer your question in writing and do so to your satisfaction, then you would embrace my call, but such would be an abomination worthy of the Lord's denunciations as depicted in *Ezek eight*. The Lord demands that, in this last day, we take Him at His word and not vest our salvation in the hands of lesser angels of light.
